Every day, tens of thousands of children around the world die from diseases that would normally be preventable and treatable. In addition, preventable health problems such as diarrhea, malnutrition, childbirth complications, wound infections, and illnesses claim the lives of thousands of adults. These people die in an environment that lacks the basic medical care and supplies they need, as they are unable to meet the minimum nutritional and health requirements to sustain life.



There are hundreds of organizations including medical institutions, relief agencies, food banks aging service groups, orphanages, schools around the world, that are working hard to help these less fortunate people. We continue to work with these charities, corporations and government agencies to improve quality standards, and to provide medical equipment and supplies, and help improve the environment for medical care and people in need, with a focus on Asia, to ensure that medical supplies are delivered timely and accurately to each region.

We are based in the United States of America, as a medical resource and humanitarian organization, has provided more than \$1 billion in supplies, to more than 800 charitable organizations in more than 140 countries worldwide since its inception.
